This journal accepts articles and original submissions that have not been published and are not under consideration for publication elsewhere. The author must indicate the relevant thematic area and send the article in Word format to the editors of the thematic area and to the journal's online submission system as soon as it is installed.

The review accepts articles in Italian, English. Manuscripts should conform to the editorial conventions set by the American Psychological Association (APA, Manual Style, 5* edition), and have a maximum length of 25.000 words with spaces (including notes and bibliographical references)

The file must be in Word format. Images, photographs, drawings must be in .jpg All submissions should be organised as follows:

1. Title page. The file should have a title page which is separate from the main body of the article. It should contain: The name of the section the submission is intended for (please double check the description of the area and its specific constraints).

1.1. Title

1.2. Name, surname, institutional affiliation, contact details of the author/ authors

1.3. A brief biographical note about the author or authors which is no longer than 75 words. If the article has more than one author please indicate the name of ONE author who will act as a contact. The title page will not undergo revision

2. The main text. The first page should contain:

2.1. A heading which will appear on every page of the document

2.2 The title

2.3. An abstract in both English and Italian (1500 words each)

2.4. Five key words in English and five keywords in Italian.

2.5. The main text of the article including notes, bibliographical references, appendixes, tables, images, charts and art work

Translations and quoting from translations When quoting from a translation or a previously published book, please use the following format.

In the text As Author claimed "children need a secure base" (Author's name, original data/data of the work you are referring to, page number of the quote). If the quote is translated in English by the author of the article, add "auth. trans." as in the example: As Rossi stated "children need a secure base" (Rossi, 1980/1995, p. 55, auth. trans).

In the reference list List the work you are referring to and provide the name of translators: Provide also the reference to the original work as in the following: Rossi, M. (1995). Title (N. Name & N. Name, Trans.). Location: Publisher. (Original work, Title. Location: Publisher, 1980).

For ancient works, use the following format as in the example provided by APA Manual Style 6th ed. Laplace, P. S. (1951). A philosophical essay on probabilities. (F. W. Truscott & F. L. Emory, Trans.). New York, NY: Dover. (Original work published 1814)



Note: When you cite a republished work, like the one above, in your text, it should appear with both dates: Laplace (1814/1951)
